



Independent Voter Network poll shows Sherman beating Berman 34% to 14%

Just released independent polling shows that Brad Sherman is leading Howard Berman by a 34% to 14% margin. Republican Mark Reed is in second place with 30%.

The polling was conducted by the Independent Voter Network (IVN) a political reform organization promoting open primaries and less partisanship in political discourse.

The IVN polling is very similar to polling conducted by The Feldman Group for the Sherman campaign which showed Sherman leading 42% to 17% over Berman with Republican Reed at 26%.

“The IVN numbers basically confirm our internal polling,” stated Sherman’s strategist Parke Skelton. “Brad is leading by more than 2 to 1 because he is much better known and has higher favorables than Howard Berman.”
