Congressman Brad Sherman scored another major labor endorsement in his re-election campaign in California's CD30 – the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades District Council 36.

The Painters District Council represents over 11,000 painters, drywall finishers, glaziers and floor-layers throughout Southern California. The endorsement letter to Congressman Sherman from the District Council's political director Robert Smith stated:
